## DIRECTIONS

### By Road

Hall Place is located just off the A2 at the Black Prince interchange 5 miles from Junction 2 of the M25 towards London. There is free parking at Hall Place and parking for coaches just outside the site on Bourne Road. For SatNavs the postcode is: DA5 1PQ

### By Rail

Nearest rail connection is Bexley BR (15 minutes walk to Hall Place or buses from Bexley village). Taxi rank at the station.

### By Bus

Bus connections include 229, 492, B12 and 132 to the foot of Gravel Hill.
