ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO NON MEMBERS

No competitor may enter more than one exhibit per class

ENTRIES WILL BE JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NAFAS
COMPETITIONS MANUAL 4TH EDITION 2023 (EXCEPT CLASS 9)

THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL

1. Natural Plant material in all its forms must predominate each exhibit.
2. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class in which there are insufficient numbers and to amend the staging accordingly.
3. All classes except **Class 8** to be staged on open tabling 76cm from the floor, covered in blue fabric.
Classes 1, 2, and 3 will be staged against a white fabric backing.
Class 8 will be hung against a pale green fabric. Please attach loop for hanging. All sizes are approximate
4. **Class 9** is **not** eligible for Best in Show award.
5. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.
All exhibits must be assembled at the venue except Classes 6,7,8, and 9 which may be assembled at home.
6. Exhibit components which are time consuming in their construction (i.e. leaf manipulation) must be made only by the exhibitor and may be brought already assembled.
7. No aerosol sprays to be used at the venue and the floor must be protected.
8. Exhibitor's property is displayed at their own risk. No liability for loss or damage can be accepted by the Society, owners or occupiers of the venue.
9. **Staging FRIDAY 30th October 2026 from 3pm – 7.30pm**
N.B. BEWARE OF THE GLADES CAR PARK CLOSING TIMES
10. **Judging to take place on Saturday morning 31st October 2026 at 9am.**
11. Exhibits must be removed from the venue by **5pm**.
12. All rubbish must be removed from the premises by the exhibitor.
13. The Judge's comment cards are **NOT** to be posted on social media.
14. Do not post photos of the exhibits on social media until closure of the Show.
